SUBJECT: PRIMARY EXIT PROFILE - GRADE 6 (PEP6) TIMETABLES FOR 2019

Dear Colleagues,

The Ministry of Education Youth and Information (MoEYI) is advising that the **Primary Exit Profile – Grade 6 (PEP6)** timetables have been dispatched to the Regional Offices. Principals are being asked to contact their respective regions to collect same.

Please be reminded that to be eligible to sit the PEP 6 students must be born during the stipulated years 2006, 2007 or 2008. Students who were granted deferral from sitting GSAT 2018 and are born 2005 must sit **ALL** components of PEP6 (Ability Test, Grade 6 Performance Tasks and Curriculum Based Tests).

Principals are being asked to ensure the following:

- All students who have been registered to sit PEP in 2019 receive a Time
 Table
- 2. The biographical information (name, date of birth and gender) must be checked for ALL students.
- 3. ALL students sitting the PEP examination must be assigned to a Grade 6 Class

ALL queries regarding timetables are to be directed to maryah.ho-young@moey.gov.jm no later than **4:00 pm** on January 21, 2019. When making queries, please use the attached excel form.

Where approved, Special Accommodations have been made for students with special needs. Please make checks with your respective Regional Office to ascertain information regarding the arrangements requested for these students.
