SUBJECT: RELEASE OF THE PRIMARY EXIT PROFILE (PEP) RESULTS GRADE FIVE - 2019

Dear Colleagues,

The results for the inaugural sitting of the Primary Exit Profile for Grade 5 - 2019 will be made available on **Friday, September 13, 2019 at 2 pm.** to schools at the Primary Level. A printed copy of the broad sheet with the summary results will be provided; however, schools will need to print the individual report for each child instead of typing up a separate report. Principals at the Primary level who may not have access to the internet and/or printing services can access and print these report at their respective Regional Office to which provisions have been made to facilitate same.

School Administrators at the Primary Level are also reminded to check the results carefully and communicate any concerns/queries by **September 30, 2019.** The queries should be emailed to terryann.thomas@moe.gov.jm

Please be reminded that to access the 'Sending School List', primary institutions should log-on to DPIS Online at www.dpisonline.com and follow the following steps:-

- Select the Year and Grade in the blue menu bar on the left
- Click Reports.
- Click the name of the report in the main window.
- The report can then be downloaded or printed using the controls at the top of the document.

- NOTE: The report may also be accessed from the **LATEST SCHOOL REPORTS** box to the right of the screen.

In cases where a School Administrator may have forgotten the password used previously, DPIS Online allows the previously registered user to change his/her password by simply performing the following steps:

1. Click the "**Forgot password**" link located below the "**Log in**" button. This will take you to the "**Forgot your password?**" page.
2. Enter the username of the account in the "**Username or email**" box.
3. Click "**Reset password**". This sends an email to the address setup on the account during registration.
4. Access your email and open the message "**Reset your password for DPIS Online.**".
5. Click the link within the message. You will be taken directly to the "**Reset your password.**" page within the DPIS Online portal.
6. Enter your new password in each of the two boxes and click the "**Set password**" button.

If the email in step 5 above does not contain a clickable link, copy the entire block, paste it in the address bar of your browser and then press the "**Enter**" key on your keyboard. This will take you to the "**Reset your password**" page within the DPIS Online portal.
