PERFORMANCE TASK EXAMINATION**

Dear Colleagues,

The Candidates' list for the Grade Five (5) Primary Exit Profile (PEP) Performance Task Examination has been submitted to your Regional Office for your collection and perusal.

ALL students **currently in Grade 5** will be required to sit the Performance Tasks in Mathematics, Language Arts, Science and Social Studies. The names of these candidates have been printed on the candidates' list.

You are being asked to review and make any necessary corrections according to the guidelines listed below:

1. Ensure that EACH candidate's FULL NAME is recorded on the Candidates' List:
 - a. Where applicable, corrections must be done to the **name, date of birth and gender** as reflected on the birth certificate. The birth certificate **MUST** accompany the list.
 - b. All corrections must be documented in the comments section on the candidates' list
2. You are **ONLY required** to submit birth certificates for those students who:
 - a. you are making corrections to name spelling, date of birth or gender
 - b. were recently transferred to your school and placed in Grade 5
 - c. are coming from a school overseas and placed in Grade 5
3. Indicate in the **Comment** section on the Candidates' List, candidates who:
 - a. have repeated (Grades 1,2, 3 or 4) – it is important to state the Grade that the student is currently in
 - b. are no longer attending your school
 - c. have migrated
4. Record all students who were transferred to your school and are now in Grade 5. **Please ensure that you record their SRN, first, middle and last**
