PRIMARY EXIT PROFILE AT GRADES 5 AND 6

Dear Colleagues,

Through established partnerships and collaboration with various stakeholder groups, the Ministry of Education, Youth and Information has adjusted the administration dates of the Grades Five and Six Primary Exit Profile (PEP) assessments. Please see the new dates reflected below for your attention:

Grade 6 Components

- Ability Test – **February 25, 2020**
- Performance Tasks for Grade 6 - **March 19 and 20, 2020**
- Curriculum Based Test - **April 23 and 24, 2020**

Grade 5 Performance Task

- Language Arts and Science - **Thursday May 28, 2020**
- Mathematics and Social Studies - **Friday May 29, 2020**

All students **currently in Grade 5** will be required to sit the Grade 5 Performance Tasks.

The Teacher Activity will be sent to the schools **One Week** before the administration of the Performance Tasks for the different grades. Teachers will use this document to familiarize the students with the areas of focus, however, **all** Performance Tasks will be presided over by external persons contracted by the Ministry of Education, Youth and Information.

School Administrators are being asked to pay close attention to the adjusted dates above and make the necessary preparations for a smooth administration.
