SUBJECT: 2021 PEP CHEETAH CHALLENGE SCHOLARSHIP

Dear Colleagues,

The Ministry of Education, Youth and Information uses this medium to advise our stakeholders, that CHEETAHTM is offering its 2nd PEP CHEETAH Challenge Scholarship in collaboration with SmartTerm, the "I Believe Initiative" (Kingston Cohort) and the Tasrell and Josephine Trowers Foundation. Any Jamaican student who is in Grade 6 and will be sitting the PEP Ability Grade 6 Test in May 2021 is eligible. The student can be from a public or private educational institution.

Interested students must register online at https://cheetah.mysmartterm.com/ and is encouraged to take an **unofficial mock test** and then an **official final test**. School administrators, teachers or students can contact CHEETAH at info@mycheetahinc.com for help with registration.

These tests, the questions of the day activity and other resources are available now at www.mycheetahinc.com and will remain open for any student who wants to practise and be familiar with how to take the CHEETAH® final test. CHEETAH's goals for this challenge scholarship are to assist students in preparing for PEP and to give-back to communities.

Students must take the final test online, any time between 6 a.m. on Friday, May 21, 2021, and 6 a.m. on Monday, May 24, 2021. There are 40 questions to be completed in 1 hour and 30 minutes. Students will see their scores for the unofficial test immediately upon submitting the test, however, the scores and the winners for the official test will be published within two days via email and telephone.

One student in each of the seven Regions with the highest score in the shortest time will be declared a winner, resulting in seven winners. Each winner will be awarded a scholarship of total value of **J\$62,000.00** in cash and prizes. There are no second or third prizes. Please see the appended flyer for your attention.

CHEETAH's resources (tests and overall content) are NOT official tests administered by the Ministry of Education, Youth & Information.
