The Ministry of Education and Youth wishes to advise our stakeholders that in an effort to help prepare our students for the upcoming Grade 5 Primary Exit Profile (PEP 5) Performance Task Tests, we have taken the decision to release some of the test items that were previously administered. Attached to this bulletin are four (4) booklets containing test items from the Grade 5 2019 iteration of the Performance Task Tests, to be used at the school level in PEP preparation programmes.

These booklets provide detailed information about each test item, as well as their solutions. School administrators and teachers are asked to use these items as a guide in developing similar items geared at assessing the skills as outlined in the National Standards Curriculum (NSC). Emphasis must be placed on ensuring that students are able to demonstrate the knowledge gained in the core subject areas.
