The Ministry of Education and Youth (MoEY) is pleased to announce that the Students' results for the 2022 Primary Exit Profile (PEP 5) examination will be made available on **Friday, November 18, 2022 at 2:00 p.m.** to schools at the primary level. School administrators should print the individual report for each child upon request from parents. School administrators may also seek the assistance of their regional office for printing of requested the results.

School administrators are also reminded to check the results carefully and communicate any concerns/queries to Mrs. Terry–Ann Thomas Gayle via email at sau@moey.gov.jm / pepaction@moey.gov.jm no later than **Friday, November 25, 2022.**

Parents will have access to their child's results on Thursday, November 24, 2022, at 2 pm. A subsequent bulletin will be sent with the relevant instructions.
