The Ministry of Education and Youth uses this medium to advise our stakeholders that student scores and placement for the 2023 Primary Exit Profile (PEP 6) will be made available to schools at the primary level on **Friday**, **June 23**, **2023 at 2:00 p.m.** Schools will need to print the individual report for each child upon request from parents who are unable to retrieve same from the Parent Portal which is an electronic interface.

The results for the secondary schools will be available on the DPIS Online Portal on **Friday**, **June 30**, **2023**.
