Instructions to Begin:

Read the Introduction to Task as well as the two sources which follow. Use them to answer the questions in Part 1 as well as to write your essay in Part 2.

Introduction to Task

The Hope Cruise Ship is planning a new cruise to the Caribbean. The Ministry of Tourism is inviting schools from your country to a meeting in which students will be asked to help Hope Cruise Ship plan their Caribbean cruise package. Hope Cruise Ship intends to stop at three Caribbean islands: Jamaica, Trinidad, and Cuba. The Ministry of Tourism needs your help in recommending Caribbean dishes that are *must-haves* when the Hope Cruise Ship passengers visit each island.

Your school was selected to participate in this meeting and was asked to give recommendations on Caribbean food. The principal of your school has selected *you* to represent your school at this meeting.

Your task is to write an essay to be read at the meeting. In your essay you are expected to recommend Caribbean dishes to the Hope Cruise Ship passengers.



You did some research on Caribbean dishes. You found two (2) useful sources. Source 1 is a table and Source 2 is a concept map.

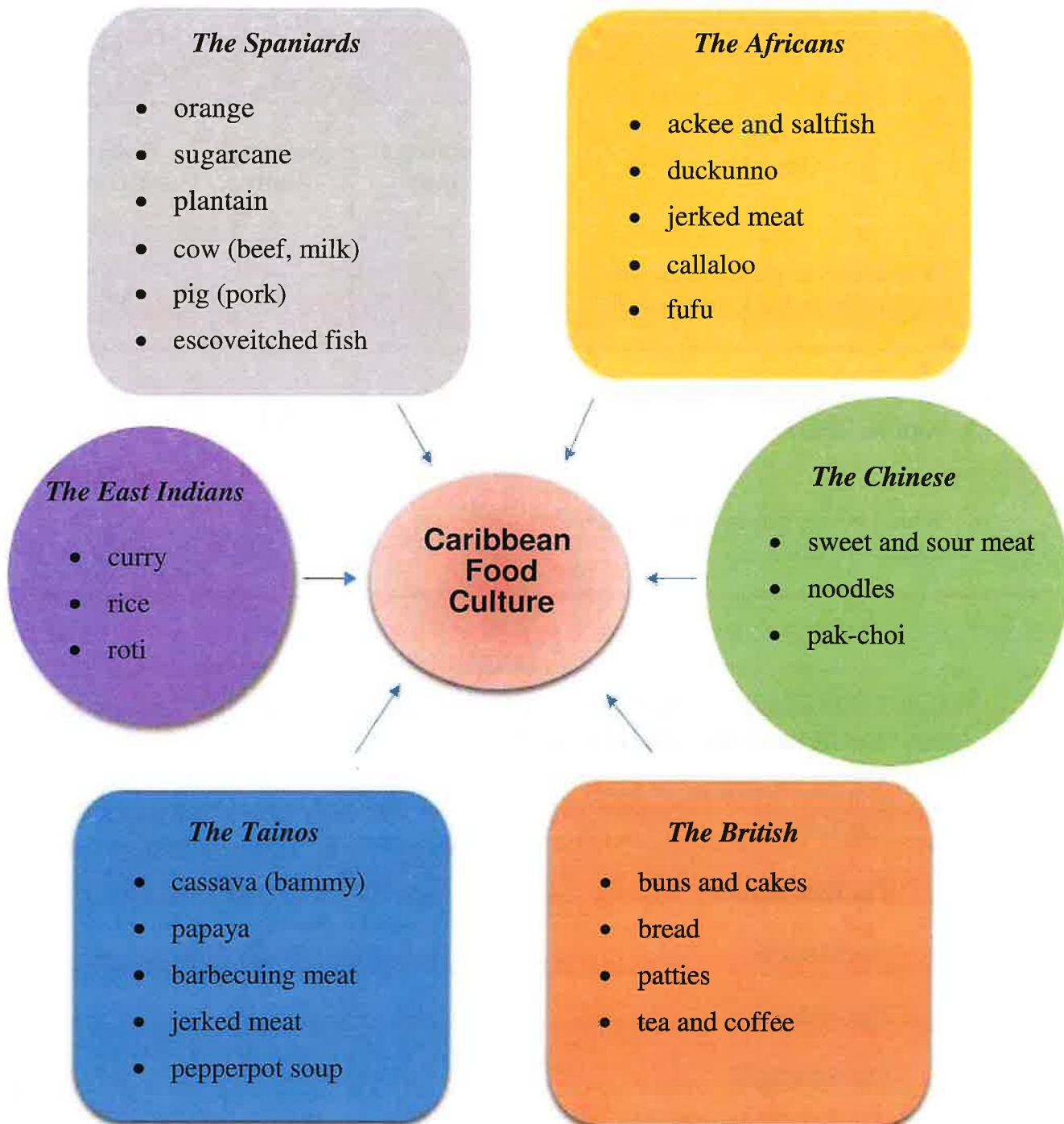

Jamaica	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ackee and saltfish• Jerk pork or jerk chicken with festival or bread• Curried chicken and rice• Escoveitched fish and bammy
Trinidad	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Doubles - pieces of fried dough filled with curried chickpeas• Curried goat with Buss-Up-Shut Roti• Trinidad style curried chicken• Trinidad style callaloo
Cuba	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ropa Vieja - shredded beef cooked in tomatoes with plantains• Tostones - green plantains fried twice• Fufú De Plátano - mashed rolled plantains and pork• Vaca Frita - shredded fried beef

"Melting pot" is a term often used to describe the mixing of different cultures to create one Caribbean culture.

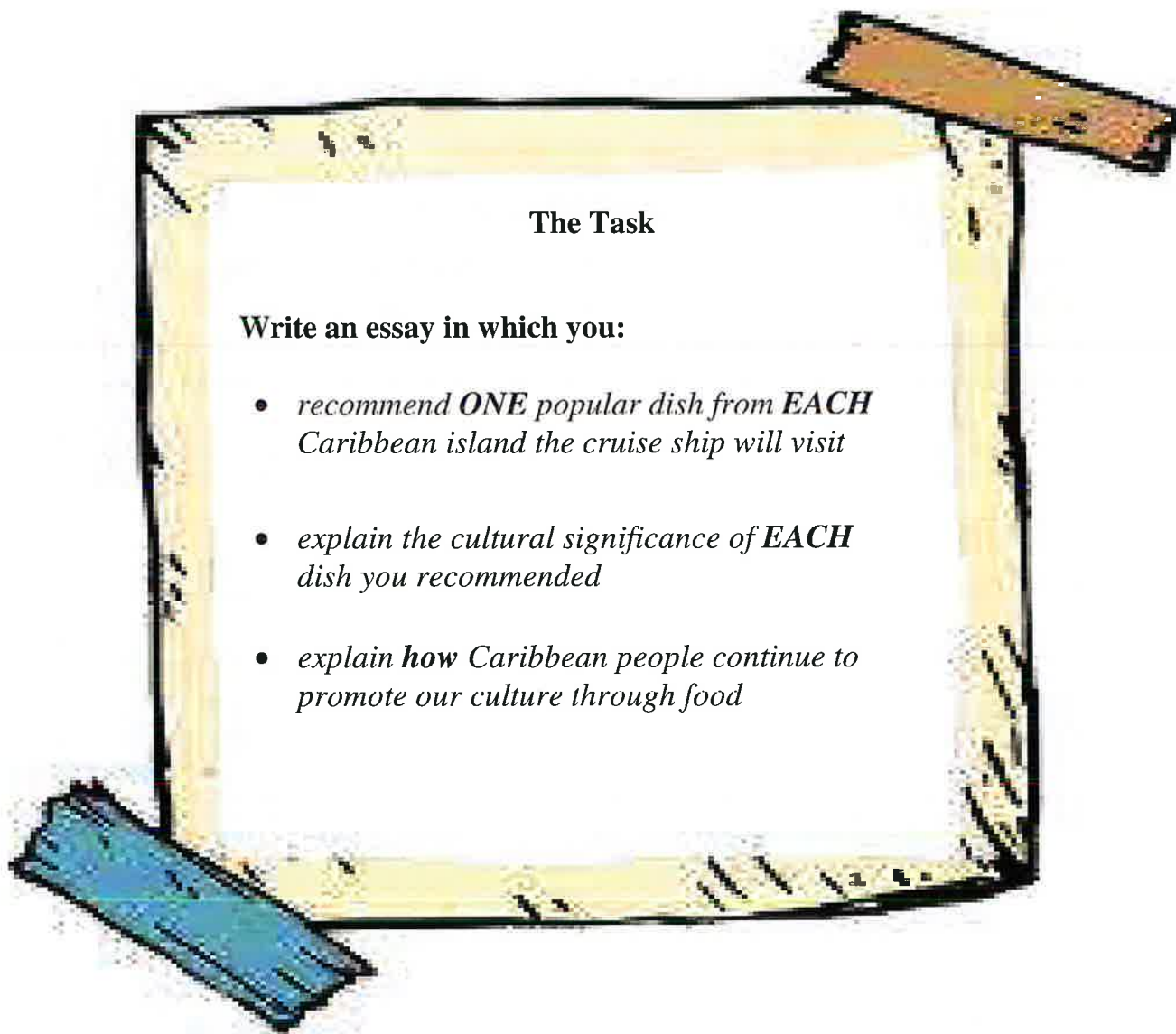
4. Using details from Source 1 and Source 2, describe **TWO** Caribbean dishes that help to explain why our food is referred to as a *"melting pot"*.
