

### The Smartphone

The iPhone's innovative design, and advanced features revolutionised the smartphone industry and set the standard for future devices.

These smartphones were made available at different prices, leading to the rapid growth and adoption of Android-based smartphones worldwide. Smartphones have made a significant impact on our daily lives in many ways. These include:
